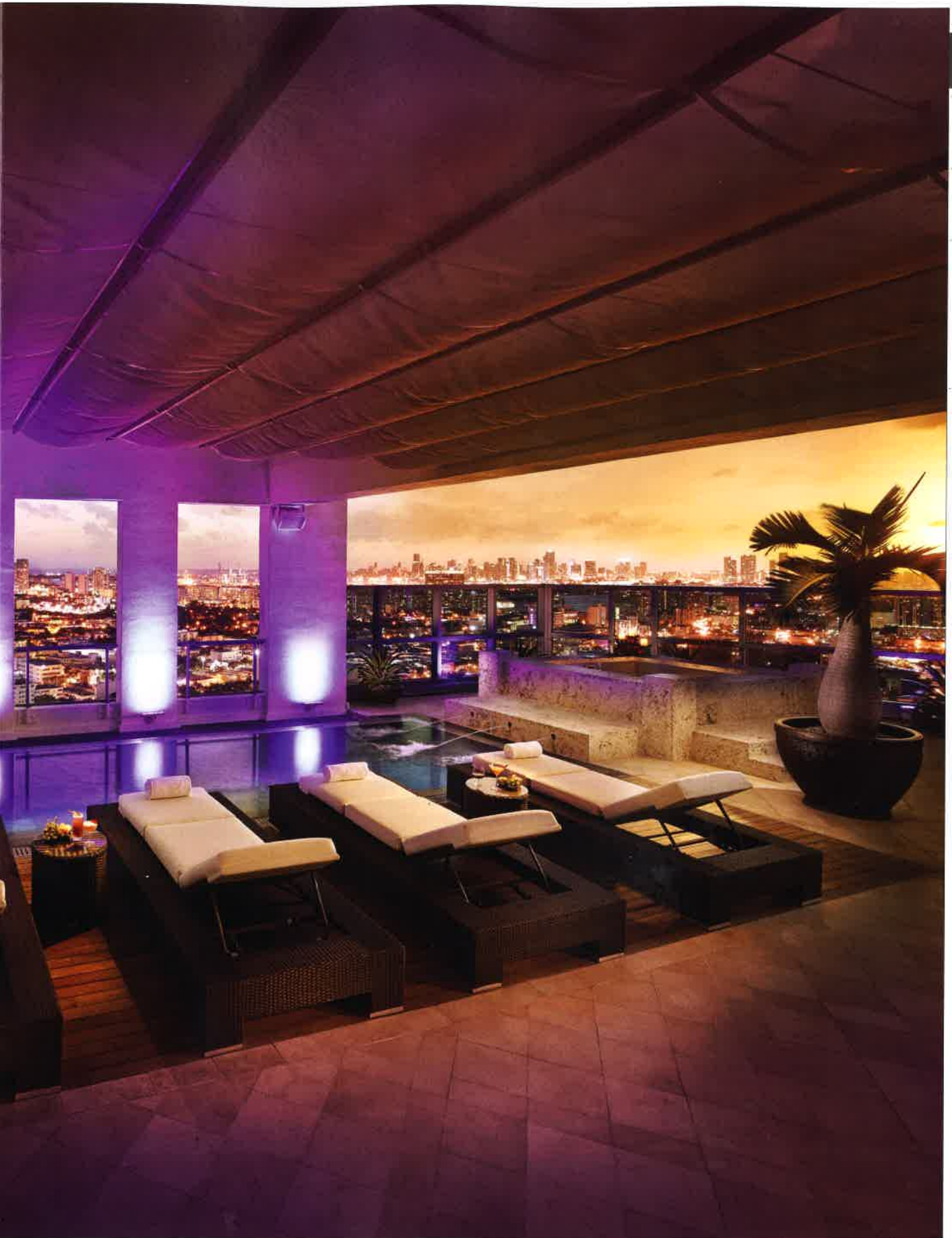
great hotel suites for families this summer

WHY THIS RESORT

The Rhode Island coast has been an enclave for affluent families since the 19th century, and Watch Hill has always been a more understated option than its flashy neighbor, Newport. For almost as long as this quiet town has been a holiday spot, Ocean House has been there: The hotel was founded in 1868. The original building was demolished in 2005 but it was reconstructed five years ago, replicating the original Victorian exterior, with larger rooms and modern amenities.

BEST FAMILY SUITE

While the resort offers cottage and villa options, the fourth-floor penthouse can't be beat in terms of views, space and perks. Ideal for large families, the 4,000-square-foot suite comprises three bedrooms, three baths and two half baths, as well as a full kitchen, two living rooms, two dining rooms, a den and a full complimentary bar stocked to your preferences. Numerous skylights, oversized windows overlooking the ocean and fresh flower arrangements make the bright decor shine. There's also a 2,000-square-foot terrace with an outdoor kitchen, wonderful for summer entertaining.

FAMILY ACTIVITIES

SandCastles, the hotel's children's program, gives kids a full agenda of recreational activities including scavenger hunts, croquet, culinary education and crafts, all supervised by YMCA counselors. Parents can take advantage of the hotel's spa, play a round of golf nearby or enjoy a drive along the coast in one of the hotel's complimentary Mercedes-Benz SL550 Roadster convertibles. "Today's travelers are on short breaks and they want to spend the time with the children," says Daniel Hostettler, president and managing director. "We want to give them every opportunity to do activities with their families, while also providing some great adult time."
